# Section IV –Requirement and description of the Services, Qualification Information and Qualifications of Staff

Procurement of customization and maintenance service of Health Information Management System (HIMS) and Related Modules of Teaching Hospital Peradeniya

#### a. Introduction of Hospital Information Management System (HIMS)

- 1. HIMS is a comprehensive software system that is capable of integrating most of the operation of a health care institution.
- 2. The HIMS is developed at the Health Information & Research Unit of National Cancer Institute Maharagama (NCIM) for the Ministry of Health of Sri Lanka.
- 3. The HIMS of the Ministry of Health has several stable modules that are readily available for any government hospital for implementation (with customization to suit the hospital).
- 4. Modules of HIMS has been implemented in several hospital in Sri Lanka namely NICM, Castle Street Women Hospital, Teaching Hospital Kurunegala, TH Ragama.
- 5. The HIMS has been developed using PHP (7+) and JavaScript as the primary programming languages. It utilizes MySQL (5.8+) and PostgreSQL (13+) as relational database management systems and adheres to HL7 standards for health data exchange and interoperability.
  - For medical imaging Oviyam and RadiAnt, DICOM, Viewers are used as DICOM viewers while DCM4CHEE serve as the picture Archiving and communication system (PACS)
- 6. Hospital Information Management System is an integrated system which covers most of hospital operations. There are several sub modules which can be implement separately in a given health care institution and integrated together later. These modules are,

#### b. Modules of the HIMS

**Module 1 - Master Patient Index (Patient admission module)** – Patient demographic data is captured in this module. Here a patient registration and the personal health number will be generated. Personal health number and other key demographic data will be shared to the national master patient index.

Module 2 - Ward admission, discharge and transfer (ADT) module – Use to admit, discharge, transfer and generation of discharge summary. This module in operation with all wards (Presently 23 Wards), NICU, Labor room, ICU, OTU, A & E. (No of wards are subject to increase according to hospital needs) Further this system is used for generation of mid night statistics and ward registers.

**Module 3 - MRO Module -** Use to generate the indoor morbidity and mortality statistics of the hospital which is integrated with the eIMMR of the medical statistics unit for data transfer.

**Module 4 – OPD Module** – Use to automate all the functions of an OPD. It has facilities for outpatient treatment, which operates in connection with the pharmacy system. OPD system is used for admission of patient for inward treatment. Further it has facilities for referring Pharmacy Module patients for clinics, dressing, physiotherapy, etc.

**Module 5 - Pharmacy Module** - This module has facilities for complete automation of drug management of all units of the hospital. This module is integrated with MSMIS of the Medical Supplies Division of the Ministry of Health.

**Module 6** – Clinic Module – Clinic module is capable of registering, appointment scheduling, handling clinical aspect related to patients, investigation and drug management of clinic patients.

Module 7 - Radiology Information System and Picture Archiving & Communication System (To be Implemented) – Use to manage all the operation of radiology department including images.

Module 8 - Theatre Module - Used for Surgical and anesthetic record keeping

Module 9 - Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS) - LIMS is capable of automating all the processes from sample tracking to enterprise resource planning of a health care institution. Bidirectional communication with analyzers.

Module 10 – Electronic Medical Record keeping & bill issuing System for Non-Sri Lankan citizens

Other related Applications - DCM4CHEE, Oviyam2, MongoDB

#### c. Scope of Work

Under the overall guidance and consultation of Health Information Unit (HIU) of Ministry of Health and direct supervision of administration of the TH Peradeniya, HIMS programmers are expected to accomplish tasks in accordance with the requirements provided below, and work in cooperation with related stakeholders in supporting project implementation by providing recurrent technical-advisory service. Under this service agreement service provider shall provide a comprehensive maintenance service and required customization of the module of HIMS mentioned under the sec. IV (b) and (c) for the Teaching Hospital Peradeniya.
